The 18th Judicial District Attorney's Office will not be filing charges on Betty Ann Habig.

We received a complaint from a citizen that Ms. Habig, a candidate for the City Council of Centennial, had distributed false campaign literature.

Upon receipt of the complaint, the DA's office assigned multiple senior attorneys and a senior investigator to look into the factual issues raised. The matter was then submitted to a bi-partisan committee of elected District Attorneys established by the Colorado District Attorneys Council (CDAC), so that they could make a non-binding recommendation to this office as to whether the evidence warranted the filing of criminal charges.

CDAC's Election Committee reviewed the case and recommended that it not be filed. After reviewing case, the team of attorneys from the DA's Office decided that no criminal charges were warranted in the matter.
