Citizens wishing to address a scheduled agenda item may be asked to speak at that particular time. Please limit comments to three minutes.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

No action may be taken during an executive session.

Executive sessions are closed to the public and are called only when necessary to discuss confidential business or personnel matters, contract negotiations, proposed property transactions, concerns about students, or to consult with legal counsel.

ACTION ITEMS

The Board may vote on these items during the current meeting.

Consent Agenda items include routine matters such as personnel recommendations, gifts to schools, and other transactions that are part of the normal operation of the school district.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

The Board does not vote on these items during the current meeting.

Discussion items return for action at a later meeting. Many of these items are being addressed for the first time and may require discussion at more than one meeting.

REPORTS

The Board does not discuss reports at the current meeting.
