

BUDGET ELECTION BALLOT QUESTION

SHALL LITTLETON PUBLIC SCHOOLS' (ARAPAHOE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 6) TAXES BE INCREASED \$6,500,000 ANNUALLY BEGINNING IN TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2005, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER BY AN ADDITIONAL PROPERTY TAX MILL LEVY SUFFICIENT TO OBTAIN SUCH INCREASE AND IN EXCESS OF THE LEVY AUTHORIZED FOR THE DISTRICT'S GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH 22-54-108, C.R.S., SUCH ADDITIONAL TAXES TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES TO BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION WHICH PURPOSES INCLUDE BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO:

- **MAINTAINING LOW CLASS-SIZES;**
- **DEDICATING RESOURCES TO ASSIST THE LOWEST PERFORMING STUDENTS IN READING, WRITING, MATH, SCIENCE AND OTHER BASIC ACADEMIC SKILLS;**
- **PROVIDING EACH CHILD ACCESS TO A COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION WITH PROGRAMS SUCH AS ART, MUSIC, AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION;**
- **CONTINUING THE DISTRICT'S COMMITMENT TO ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY**

AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, SHALL LITTLETON PUBLIC SCHOOLS BE AUTHORIZED TO RAISE AND EXPEND SUCH TAXES AND THE EARNINGS FROM THE INVESTMENT OF SUCH REVENUES FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AS A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, NOTWITHSTANDING THE SPENDING LIMITATIONS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 (7) OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?
